At this time no one in our Home has COVID 19. Nursing staff are closely monitoring the Residents for COVID 19 symptoms.

We must continue to restrict visitors, volunteers and outside vendors. As per the Minnesota Dept. of Health guidelines all staff are wearing facemasks and those staff providing direct care are wearing protective eyewear throughout their shifts and are being screened per CDC/MDH recommendation. Housekeeping continues to disinfect all areas of the Home throughout the day.

Our Residents are privileged to still have daily Mass, which is available to them on our in-house television channel and followed by communion rounds by five Little Sisters. Residents are keeping contact with their families via phone, video calls, letters, notes, and window visits on the first floor. We were blessed to have Archbishop Hebda and Bishop Cozzens here this past weekend in our parking lot to say a decade of the Rosary for everyone's health, safety and spiritual needs. We are continually saying special prayers for an end to this coronavirus pandemic.
