Mass is so important to many of the Residents, they are delighted to be able to watch Mass again on our in-house television channel. Many are very happy to be able to start going outside to the backyard to enjoy the warm weather and the beautiful flowers.

Residents are monitored very closely for signs and symptoms of the virus. Staff are screened daily for symptoms. As for right now, we are testing once a week per the guidelines of the CDC/MDH. Residents, Staff and Sisters are being reminded of social distancing, wearing of masks and proper PPE and handwashing and using sanitizer. We have added many sanitizer stations throughout the building and will be adding more.
